- (a) No person may willfully conceal material facts or make false, fictitious, or fraudulent statements or representations or willfully use any false writing or document containing false, fictitious, or fraudulent statements in meeting the requirements of any order, rule or regulation promulgated pursuant to [Article 41,] § 2-101[,] OF THIS ARTICLE or in the application for any service or benefit provided by the State in the allocation or assignment of energy supplies.
