

WATERS MAY BE DIRECTLY AFFECTED BY THE PROPOSED REGULATIONS for [two] 2 successive weeks in advance of the hearings. [After the hearings are held and the rules and regulations are adopted, the rules and regulations shall be published for one week in the newspapers bearing notice of the hearing.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

CHAPTER 95  
(Senate Bill 181)

AN ACT concerning

**Anne Arundel County – Sheriff – Salary**

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the Sheriff of Anne Arundel County; and providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the incumbent Sheriff of Anne Arundel County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings  
Section 2-309(c)(1)  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(1989 Replacement Volume)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

2-309.

(c) (1) The Sheriff of Anne Arundel County shall receive a salary of [\$37,500] ~~\$50,000~~ \$42,000.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Anne Arundel County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Anne Arundel County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
