Administration shall issue the same type of registration plates as that issued for a private passenger vehicle.

- (2) IN ADDITION TO THE OTHER REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION, EACH REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION FOR A RENTAL VEHICLE SHALL DISPLAY A SYMBOL AS PRESCRIBED BY THE ADMINISTRATION THAT CLEARLY IDENTIFIES THE VEHICLE AS A RENTAL VEHICLE.
- (E) A PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS RENTED OR BEING OFFERED FOR RENT IN THIS STATE WITHOUT A DRIVER SHALL DISPLAY A DISTINCTIVE REGISTRATION PLATE AS AUTHORIZED AND ISSUED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990 January 1, 1991.
