Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

30B.

- (A) THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A CLASS B SPECIAL THEATER (ON-SALE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE OR A CLASS D (ON SALE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE FOR USE IN A THEATER IF THE THEATER:
  - (1) IS HOUSED WITHIN A BUILDING;
- (2) HAS A CAPACITY TO HOLD A MINIMUM OF 1,500 PERMANENTLY INSTALLED SEATS; AND
  - (3) REGULARLY PRESENTS LIVE ENTERTAINMENT.
- (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE TO THE CONTRARY, A HOLDER IS AUTHORIZED TO SELL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR AT RETAIL FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION:
  - (1) FOR 2 HOURS BEFORE THE ENTERTAINMENT BEGINS:
  - (2) DURING THE ENTERTAINMENT; AND
  - (3) FOR 1 HOUR AFTER THE ENTERTAINMENT.
  - (C) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$1,000.
- (D) A SPECIAL THEATER (ON-SALE) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO A LOCATION OTHER THAN THE LOCATION OF ORIGINAL ISSUANCE.
- (C) (E) THE BALTIMORE COUNTY POPULATION QUOTA PROVISIONS POPULATION REQUIREMENTS OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS DO NOT APPLY TO A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1990.
