SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 48A - Insurance Code

175A.

In lieu of or in addition to, suspension or revocation of the certificate of an agent or broker, the Commissioner may impose a penalty of not less than [\$25.00] \$100 nor more than [\$500.00] \$500 FOR EACH VIOLATION OF § 175 OF THIS ARTICLE from the agent or broker whose certificate is subject to suspension or revocation under this article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
