CHAPTER 128

(House Bill 142)

AN ACT concerning

**Agriculture – Weights and Measures – Fluid Milk Products**

FOR the purpose of adding to the kinds of packaging units that are allowed for the retail sale of fluid dairy products.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – Agriculture

Section 11-312(a)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1985 Replacement Volume and 1989 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – Agriculture**

11-312.

(a) All fluid dairy products, including whole milk, skimmed milk, cultured milk, sweet cream, and buttermilk shall be packaged for retail sale only in units of 1 gill, one-half liquid pint, 10 fluid ounces, 12 FLUID OUNCES, 1 liquid pint, 1 liquid quart, or multiples of 1 quart. However, packages in units of less than 1 gill shall be permitted.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
