- (2) The Task Force shall be composed of:
- (i) 1 member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House, and 1 member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate;
- (ii) 1 representative of the Department of Natural Resources, appointed by the Secretary of Natural Resources;
- (iii) 1 representative of the Maryland Department of Agriculture, appointed by the Secretary of Agriculture;
- (iv) 1 representative of the University of Maryland with expertise in environmental issues, appointed by the Chancellor;
- (iii) (v) 1 representative of the Department of the Environment, appointed by the Secretary of the Environment;
- (iv) (vi) 1 representative of the State Highway Administration of the Department of Transportation, appointed by the Secretary of Transportation;
- (v) (vii) 1 representative of the Office of State Planning, appointed by the Director of the Office;
- (vi) (viii) 1 representative of the Maryland Association of Counties, appointed by the Governor;
- (vii) (ix) 1 representative of the Maryland Municipal League, appointed by the Governor;
- $\frac{\text{(viii)}}{\text{(x)}}$ 1 representative of the Maryland Homebuilder's Association, appointed by the Governor;
- $\frac{\text{(ix)}}{\text{(xi)}}$ 1 representative of the agricultural community, appointed by the Governor;
- (x) (xii) 1 representative of the environmental community, appointed by the Governor;
- $\frac{\text{(xii)}}{\text{(xiii)}}$ 1 representative of the scientific research community, appointed by the Governor; and
- (xii) (xiv) 1 interested member 2 members of the general public interested in stream quality, appointed by the Governor.
 - (3) The Governor shall designate the chairman of the Task Force.
- (4) The Department of Natural Resources shall provide staff for the Task Force.
- (4) The Department of Natural Resources shall coordinate with other State agencies to provide staffing for the Task Force.
