

(2) The Task Force shall be composed of:

(i) 1 member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House, and 1 member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate;

(ii) 1 representative of the Department of Natural Resources, appointed by the Secretary of Natural Resources;

(iii) 1 representative of the Maryland Department of Agriculture, appointed by the Secretary of Agriculture;

(iv) 1 representative of the University of Maryland with expertise in environmental issues, appointed by the Chancellor;
