SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

- (a) The Commission to Save the Lighthouses is established to investigate the problems of saving lighthouses in Maryland waters.
- (e) The Commission shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and, consistent with § 2-1312 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly by July 1, [1990] 1991, and thereafter terminate its existence.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
