(c) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, on retirement a member shall receive:

(i) A service retirement allowance that shall be computed as [a] 1 percent of the part of the member’s average final compensation that is not in excess of the social security integration level, plus 1.5 percent of the part of that compensation that is in excess of the social security integration level, multiplied by the number of years of the member’s creditable service; or
