CHARTERED ASSOCIATION ON AND AFTER JUNE 30, 1992 SHALL DIVEST ITSELF OF ANY DEPOSIT TAKING OFFICES IN MARYLAND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 9–1006 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

CHAPTER 150

(House Bill 287)

AN ACT concerning

<u>Professional Solicitors - Reports</u> <u>Charitable Organization Registration - Professional Solicitor Reports</u>

FOR the purpose of altering the financial information required to be filed with the Secretary of State by certain charitable organizations under certain circumstances; authorizing the Secretary of State to assign to a charitable organization a certain date on which its annual report is due; providing that the date shall be no earlier than a certain time after the close of the charitable organization's fiscal year; repealing a requirement that a professional solicitor file a certain report within 30 days after the anniversary date of the professional solicitor's registration with the Secretary of State; providing that a professional solicitor who has not filed a certain report before a certain time shall file a certain report with its application to renew registration; and generally relating to professional solicitors and reports of professional solicitors charitable organization registration and reports and professional solicitor reports.
