- (a) A hazardous chemical includes any substance which meets the definition of health hazard adopted by the United States Occupational Safety and Health Administration and published in the Federal Register on November 25, 1983, as amended from time to time, unless the Commissioner objects to an amendment.
- (b) If the Commissioner objects to an amendment, the Commissioner shall publish and make public the reasons for such objection and shall afford all interested parties an opportunity to be heard.
- (c) At the conclusion of a hearing, the Commissioner shall publish and make public a decision, which shall be final.]
