

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

[(r) In Queen Anne’s County the chairman of the board of license commissioners shall receive as compensation the sum of \$750 per year. Each of the other members shall receive as compensation the sum of \$700 per year.]

(R) (1) IN QUEEN ANNE’S COUNTY, THE COMPENSATION FOR THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL BE AT THE RATE TO BE DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

(2) THE RATE MAY NOT BE LESS THAN:

- (1) \$65 PER MEETING FOR THE CHAIRMAN; AND
- (2) \$60 PER MEETING FOR EACH REGULAR MEMBER.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the chairman or regular members of the Queen Anne’s County Board of License Commissioners in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the chairman or regular members of the Queen Anne’s County Board of License Commissioners shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

CHAPTER 161

(House Bill 404)

AN ACT concerning

Hunting with Falcons, Hawks, or Owls

FOR the purpose of exempting certain persons hunting with falcons, hawks, or owls during the open season from certain clothing requirements for hunters.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
