

Article – Natural Resources

10-418.

(a) This section does not apply to any person who:

(1) Hunts any wildlife on the person’s property with or without a hunter’s license;

(2) Hunts deer with a bow and arrow during the season restricted to hunting with a bow and arrow; [or]

(3) HUNTS GAME BIRDS OR MAMMALS DURING THE OPEN SEASON USING FALCONS, HAWKS, OR OWLS; OR

[(3)] (4) Hunts the following species:

(i) Wetland game birds;

(ii) Fur-bearing mammals;

(iii) Crows;

(iv) Doves; or

(v) Wild turkeys.

(b) The following persons shall wear either a cap, vest, jacket, or jacket containing back and front panels of a daylight fluorescent orange color:

(1) A person who hunts any wildlife; and

(2) A person who accompanies, aids, or assists another person to hunt any wildlife.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

CHAPTER 162

(House Bill 418)

AN ACT concerning

Duck Blinds – Frog Mortar Creek – Baltimore County

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the erection, maintenance, or licensing of certain duck blinds in a certain portion of Frog Mortar Creek in Baltimore County.
