

coordination of transit planning and general planning, be prepared in consultation with THE STATE RAILROAD ADMINISTRATION, PASSENGER SERVICES AND WITH the Regional Planning Council.

(b) The Administration shall cooperate with the planning agencies of the Office of Planning and any other State or federal agency concerned with transit plans.

(c) To provide a framework for regional participation in the planning process, the Administration may create technical committees concerned with planning and the collection and analyses of information to aid in the transportation planning process. On request of the Administration, the Office of Planning may make appointments to these committees.

(a) In addition to the specific powers granted under this title, the Administration has the powers granted by this section.

(N) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL COOPERATE WITH THE MASS TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION IN THE PREPARATION OF TRANSIT PLANS PREPARED IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 7, SUBTITLE 3 OF THIS ARTICLE.

CHAPTER 181

(House Bill 820)

AN ACT concerning

St. Mary's County – County Commissioners – Salaries

FOR the purpose of altering the salaries of the President and other County Commissioners of St. Mary's County; providing for the application of this Act; clarifying language; and providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the incumbent President or of the other County Commissioners.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
