- (B) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, "FAMILY" MEANS:
 - (I) THE APPLICANT;
- (II) THE APPLICANT'S SPOUSE IF THE SPOUSE LIVES WITH THE APPLICANT; AND
- (III) THE APPLICANT'S CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 21 YEARS IF THE CHILDREN LIVE WITH THE APPLICANT.
- (2) IF THE APPLICANT IS A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 21 YEARS, "FAMILY" MEANS:
 - (I) THE MINOR APPLICANT'S PARENTS; AND
- (II) AT THE OPTION OF THE MINOR APPLICANT'S PARENTS, THE MINOR APPLICANT'S SIBLINGS.

- (A) THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE SHALL MAINTAIN ADMINISTER A MARYLAND AIDS INSURANCE ASSISTANCE PILOT PROGRAM FOR HIV POSITIVE INDIVIDUALS.
- (B) THERE SHALL BE NO MORE THAN 150 RECIPIENTS ENROLLED IN THE PROGRAM AT ANY 1 TIME.
 - (B) (C) AN INDIVIDUAL IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE PROGRAM IF:
- (1) CASH ASSETS OWNED BY THE INDIVIDUAL'S FAMILY, INCLUDING SAVINGS ACCOUNTS, CHECKING ACCOUNTS, AND STOCKS AND BONDS, DO NOT EXCEED \$10,000;
- (2) THE INDIVIDUAL'S FAMILY INCOME, EARNED AND UNEARNED, DOES NOT EXCEED 200 PERCENT OF THE FEDERAL POVERTY LEVEL;
