

Commission relating to publicly owned watershed property in the Washington Suburban Sanitary District.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 29 – Washington Suburban Sanitary District

18-104.1.

(b) (1) Any violation of a watershed rule or regulation is a “WSSC infraction”, unless the violation is declared by law to be a criminal offense. For the purpose of this article, a WSSC infraction is a civil offense.

(4) (i) A preset fine not to exceed [\$20] \$50 may be imposed for each conviction of a WSSC infraction.

(ii) The WSSC may establish a schedule of preset fines for each conviction of a WSSC infraction, which is payable by the recipient of the citation to the WSSC within 20 calendar days of the receipt of the citation.

(iii) Repeat offenders may be assessed a preset fine not to exceed [\$40] \$100 for each repeat offense.

(7) If any person is found by the District Court to have committed a WSSC infraction, the person shall be required to pay a fine in an amount not to exceed [\$20] \$50 or, in the event that the infraction is a repeat offense, [\$40] \$100.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.
