

Property Tax Assessment Appeal Board – Compensation

FOR the purpose of altering the compensation for members of a property tax assessment appeal board; providing that a member of a property tax assessment appeal board is entitled to compensation at an hourly rate as provided in the State budget; providing for the effective dates of this Act; and generally relating to compensation of members of a property tax assessment appeal board.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Tax – Property

3-105.

(c) Each member of a board is entitled to:

- (1) compensation in accordance with the State budget at the rate of [\$20] \$25 an hour but not exceeding [\$120] \$150 for each day or part of a day spent in hearing protests or in executive session; and
- (2) reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(c) Each member of a board is entitled to:

- (1) compensation [in accordance with the State budget at the rate of \$25 an hour but not exceeding \$150 for each day or part of a day spent in hearing protests or in executive session] AT AN HOURLY RATE AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET; and
