SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

- (d) "Governing board" means:
 - (1) The Board of Regents of the University of Maryland System;
 - (2) The Board of Regents of Morgan State University; [and]
 - (3) The Board of Trustees of St. Mary's College of Maryland; AND
- (4) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF MARYLAND AT BALTIMORE NEW COMMUNITY COLLEGE AT OF BALTIMORE.

(b) (1) The Secretary shall:

- (i) Select, organize, and direct the staff of the Commission;
- (ii) Perform the duties the Commission assigns;
- (iii) See that the policies and decisions of the Commission are carried

out;

- (iv) Serve at the pleasure of the Commission; [and]
- (v) Be a member of the Governor's Executive Council; AND

(VI) ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT DESCRIBE THE CLASS OR CLASSES OF PROPOSED ACTIONS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE NEW COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF BALTIMORE THAT SHALL REQUIRE THE PRIOR APPROVAL OF THE SECRETARY.

- (g) (1) On or before a date set by the Commission, each of the following governing boards and agencies shall submit to the Commission its annual operating budget requests and proposals for capital projects, by constituent institutions for the next fiscal year:
 - (i) The Board of Regents of the University of Maryland System;
 - (ii) The Board of Regents of Morgan State University;
 - (iii) The Board of Trustees of St. Mary's College of Maryland;
 - (iv) The State Board for Community Colleges;
