EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE COLLEGE AND THE CHIEF OF STAFF FOR THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

- (II) THE OFFICE OF PRESIDENT IS A POSITION THAT EXISTS FROM JUNE 1, 1990 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1993.
- (2) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY CREATE OTHER OFFICES IN THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF QUALIFIED PERSONS TO THOSE OFFICES.
- (I) SUBJECT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE BOARD FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGES STATED IN SUBTITLE 1 OF THIS TITLE AND THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY:
- (1) ESTABLISH ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE;
 - (2) APPROVE COURSES AND PROGRAMS;
 - (3) ADOPT AND CHANGE CURRICULA; AND
- (4) ESTABLISH AND CHANGE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE AWARDING OF CREDITS AND DEGREES AND FOR GRADUATION: AND
- (5) WORK WITH THE STATE BOARD FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGES TO ESTABLISH COOPERATIVE PROGRAM AGREEMENTS THAT QUALIFY AS STATEWIDE PROGRAMS IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 16-407(D) OF THIS ARTICLE; AND
- (6) DEVELOP EFFECTIVE RELATIONSHIPS AND COOPERATIVE PROGRAMS WITH THE BALTIMORE CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM TO ASSURE THAT HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO ENROLL IN THE NEW COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF BALTIMORE.
- (J) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY FIX THE SALARIES AND TENURE TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT OF THE PRESIDENT, FACULTY, AND OFFICERS OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE.
- (K) IN ADDITION TO ANY PERFORMANCE EVALUATION REQUIRED BY REGULATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL EVALUATE THE PERFORMANCE OF THE FACULTY OF THE COLLEGE IN A FORM DEVELOPED IN COOPERATION WITH THE COMMISSION AND THE STATE BOARD FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGES.
- $\frac{(K)}{(L)}$ THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY ENTER INTO CONTRACTS OR DELEGATE THAT AUTHORITY TO THE PRESIDENT.
