- (1) REPORT DIRECTLY TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES;
- (2) ATTEND ALL MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, EXCEPT THAT THE PRESIDENT MAY BE EXCUSED BY THE BOARD FROM DISCUSSIONS CONCERNING THE PRESIDENT OR THE POSITION OF THE PRESIDENT:
- (3) BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE EVERYDAY ADMINISTRATION OF THE COLLEGE AND ITS DEPARTMENTS;
- (2) BE RESPONSIBLE AND ACCOUNTABLE TO THE BOARD FOR THE DISCIPLINE AND SUCCESSFUL CONDUCT OF THE COLLEGE AND SUPERVISION OF EACH OF ITS DEPARTMENTS;
 - (3) TAKE EVERY INITIATIVE IN:
- (I) IMPLEMENTING THE POLICIES OF THE BOARD AND THE COLLEGE; AND
- (II) PROMOTING THE DEVELOPMENT AND EFFICIENCY OF THE COLLEGE;
- (4) HIRE AND DISCHARGE FACULTY AND EMPLOYEES AS AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES; AND
- (5) ATTEND ALL MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, EXCEPT THAT THE PRESIDENT MAY BE EXCUSED BY THE BOARD FROM DISCUSSIONS CONCERNING THE PRESIDENT OR THE POSITION OF PRESIDENT; AND
- $\stackrel{\mbox{\scriptsize (5)}}{}$ $\stackrel{\mbox{\scriptsize (6)}}{}$ CARRY OUT OTHER DUTIES AS AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.
- (B) THE PRESIDENT MAY DELEGATE ANY PORTION OF THE PRESIDENT'S AUTHORITY TO OTHER OFFICERS OF THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE, SUBJECT TO THE RIGHT OF THE PRESIDENT OR THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO RESCIND OR MODIFY THE DELEGATION IN WHOLE OR IN PART AT ANY TIME.

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- (A) EACH YEAR FOR FISCAL YEARS 1992 AND 1993, THE PRESIDENT SHALL PREPARE AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL REVIEW, REVISE MODIFY, AS NECESSARY, AND APPROVE AN OPERATING BUDGET AND A CAPITAL BUDGET FOR THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE.
 - (B) THE OPERATING BUDGET SHALL INDICATE:
- (1) ALL REVENUES ESTIMATED FOR THE NEXT FISCAL YEAR CLASSIFIED BY FUNDS AND SOURCES OF INCOME; AND
 - (2) ALL EXPENDITURES REQUESTED, INCLUDING
