(2) BE RESPONSIBLE AND ACCOUNTABLE TO THE BOARD FOR THE DISCIPLINE AND SUCCESSFUL CONDUCT OF THE COLLEGE AND SUPERVISION OF EACH OF ITS DEPARTMENTS;

(3) TAKE EVERY INITIATIVE IN:

(I) IMPLEMENTING THE POLICIES OF THE BOARD AND THE COLLEGE; AND

(II) PROMOTING THE DEVELOPMENT AND EFFICIENCY OF THE COLLEGE;

(4) HIRE AND DISCHARGE FACULTY AND EMPLOYEES AS AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES; ~~AND~~

(A) ~~EACH YEAR~~ FOR FISCAL YEARS 1992 AND 1993, THE PRESIDENT SHALL PREPARE AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL REVIEW, ~~REVISE~~ MODIFY, AS NECESSARY, AND APPROVE AN OPERATING BUDGET AND A CAPITAL BUDGET FOR THE ~~COMMUNITY~~ COLLEGE.
