SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

18-302.

- (a) (1) Except for A SENATORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD UNDER SUBTITLE 4 OF THIS TITLE, A DELEGATE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD UNDER SUBTITLE 5 OF THIS TITLE, OR a distinguished scholar award under § 18 1101 of this [article] TITLE AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, the recipient of a general State scholarship may not hold any other scholarship awarded under this title.
- (2) THE RECIPIENT OF A GENERAL STATE SCHOLARSHIP SIMULTANEOUSLY MAY HOLD:
- (I) A DISTINGUISHED SCHOLAR AWARD UNDER § 18-1101 OF THIS TITLE; AND
- (II) EITHER ONE SENATORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD UNDER SUBTITLE 4 OF THIS TITLE OR ONE DELEGATE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD UNDER SUBTITLE 5 OF THIS TITLE.
 - (b) (1) Each applicant for a general State-scholarship shall:
- (i) Take a competitive examination administered by the State Scholarship Administration; and
- (ii) Be accepted for admission in the regular undergraduate program at an eligible institution or be enrolled in a two year terminal certificate program in which the course work is acceptable for transfer credit for an accredited baccalaureate program in an eligible institution.
 - (2) An applicant is exempt from the examination if the applicant:
- (i) Is attending an eligible institution and has completed at least 1 year in good academic standing at the institution;
- (ii) Graduated from high school at least 5 years before applying for a general State scholarship; or
- (iii) Is planning to attend or is attending a Maryland community college.
