OR BY ANY OTHER OFFICIAL OR UNIT OF THE STATE; AND

- (3) (I) A TRUSTEE, EMPLOYEE, OR AGENT OF THE BOARD OR THE FUND MAY NOT BE DEEMED A PUBLIC OFFICIAL OF THE STATE BY VIRTUE OF ANY ACTIONS ON BEHALF OF THE FUND.
- (II) MEETINGS OF THE TRUSTEES, THE BOARD, OR OF EMPLOYEES OR AGENTS OF THE FUND, ARE NOT SUBJECT TO ANY STATE REQUIREMENTS FOR OPEN OR PUBLIC MEETINGS, INCLUDING ANY REQUIREMENTS FOR OPEN SESSIONS SET FORTH IN TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 5 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE OF THE CODE.
- (C) THE FUND SHALL BE EXEMPT FROM THE LICENSING AND OTHER REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS OF TITLE 11, SUBTITLE 5 OF THE FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS ARTICLE OF THE CODE.
