LAWS OF MARYLAND

MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 25 - County Commissioners

3.

- (1) (1) To provide for competitive bidding for any county work and the making and awarding of contracts for the purchase of materials and supplies in excess of \$500 and to require bonds in connection with the work or contracts, whenever deemed proper; and if no bids are submitted in response to any calls therefor, to place the order as in their discretion they deem best.
- (2) (i) The contracts shall be in excess of the amounts specified for the counties set forth in this paragraph.
 - (ii) Allegany County-\$5,000
 - (iii) Carroll County-\$3,500
 - (iv) Charles County—[\$2,500] \$5,000
 - (v) Frederick County—\$10,000
 - (vi) Garrett County-\$5,000
 - (vii) Harford County-\$1,000
 - (viii) Kent County—\$5,000
 - (ix) St. Mary's County—\$5,000
 - (x) Somerset County—\$4,000
 - (xi) Talbot County—\$1,000
 - (xii) Worcester County—\$2,500

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1990.

CHAPTER 233

(Senate Bill 67)

AN ACT concerning

Charles County - Fire and Rescue Tax
