## AN ACT concerning

Allegany County - Property Tax Credit - Frostburg Community Hospital, Inc.

FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing body of Allegany County <u>or a municipal corporation in Allegany County</u> to grant, by law, a property tax credit against <u>the county or municipal corporation property tax imposed on</u> certain property leased by Frostburg Community Hospital, Inc. <u>and used for certain purposes.</u>

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Tax - Property

9 - 302.

AND

- (b) The governing body of Allegany County or of a municipal corporation in Allegany County may grant, by law, a property tax credit under this section against the county or municipal corporation property tax imposed on:
  - (1) property that is:
- (i) owned by the National Board of Young Men's Christian Associations; and
  - (ii) known as the Railroad YMCA of Cumberland;
- (2) property that is owned by the Upper Potomac Jaycees, Incorporated; [and]
- (3) property that is owned by the Allegany Beagle Club, Incorporated; AND
  - (4) PROPERTY THAT IS:
    - (I) LEASED BY FROSTBURG COMMUNITY HOSPITAL, INC.;
  - (II) USED FOR HOSPITAL PURPOSES.
