(A) REGISTERED NURSES WHO GRADUATED PRIOR TO SEPTEMBER, 1979 FROM DIPLOMA NURSING PROGRAMS OR ASSOCIATE DEGREE NURSING PROGRAMS MAY VALIDATE PRIOR LEARNING, PRIOR TO ENTERING A BACCALAUREATE NURSING PROGRAM, BY SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETING THE FOLLOWING 3 TRANSITION COURSES:

(1) SCIENTIFIC CONCEPTS;

(2) CONCEPTS IN THE SOCIAL SCIENCES AND HUMANITIES;

AND

(3) NURSING CONCEPTS.

(B) THE TRANSITION COURSES SHALL BE TAKEN AT AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT HAS RECEIVED APPROVAL FROM THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION, IN
