

as aforesaid upon the property so sold, the cost of such sale or sales, the cost of advertising, and three *per cent.* commission to himself, in addition to the commission herein after mentioned and allowed, shall pay over the balance to the person or persons entitled thereto. CHAP. 239.

6. *And be it enacted,* That each of the members of the said board of commissioners shall be allowed two dollars per day for each day they are employed in the carrying into effect the provisions of this law, and that the collector of the city of Baltimore shall be allowed three *per cent.* on all sums collected by him under the provisions of this law, which *per diem* and commissions are to be considered as a part of the expense necessary for the carrying of this law into execution, and are to be assessed and levied as is herein before mentioned. Allowance to commissioners

7. *And be it enacted,* That the grade of said street shall not be considered to be altered and established, until the damages to be by each person sustained and assessed as aforesaid, shall be first paid to the mayor and city council of Baltimore, for the use of the person or persons entitled to receive the same. Grade not to be altered before damages are paid

8. *And be it enacted,* That nothing in this act contained shall be of any force or effect until approved of by the mayor and city council of Baltimore. Act to be approved of, &c

9. *And be it enacted,* That upon the approval of this act by the mayor and city council of Baltimore aforesaid, any and all such acts of assembly as may be inconsistent with or repugnant to the provisions of this act, be and the same is hereby repealed. Upon approval, acts inconsistent repealed

CHAP. CCXL.

An Act Supplemental to an Act passed at December Session 1825, chapter 199. Passed Mar 12 1827

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That from and after the passage of this act, it shall be the duty of the judges of the first judicial district of this state, to give the act, to which this is a supplement, in charge to the grand juries of the several counties composing the same, at each and every court to be hereafter held therein. Act to be given in charge to grand juries

CHAP. CCXLI.

An Act Supplementary to an Act passed at November Session seventeen hundred and ninety-seven, chapter eleven. Passed Mar 12 1827

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the operation of the provisions of the act of assembly, passed at November session seventeen hundred and ninety-seven, chapter eleven, to which this is a supplement, shall be and hereby is extended to the city of Baltimore as the bounds and limits of that city are at present extended. Provisions of original act extended, &c

CHAP. CCXLII.

An Act for the relief of Basil Bowling, of Prince-George's County. Passed Mar 12 1827

1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the treasurer of the western shore, in settling the account Treasurer to allow for insolvencies.
