LIBRARY.	A library established for the use of the legislature, and a librarian to be appointed. His duties and salary, 53

LIGHT-HOUSES.	The commissioners of the town of Havre-de-Grace authorised to sell to the United States a site for a light-house upon certain streets in the town, 201 Commissioners appointed (in the event of the United States failing to purchase from the commissioners of Havre-de-Grace,) to fix a value upon any site to be selected at or near Point Concord, &c. <i>Ib.</i> The right of jurisdiction of this state to be relinquished. Ceded to the United States, <i>Ib.</i> The like over the ground heretofore contracted for as sites for a light-house on Cove-Point, in Calvert county, <i>Ib.</i>
LIMITATION OF APPEALS, &c.	No writ of error or appeal shall be prosecuted upon any judgment after three years shall elapse from the time the judgment was rendered, except writs of error <i>coram vobis</i> , 200 No appeal from any decree of the court of chancery, or county court sitting as a court of equity, shall be made after nine months from the time the decree was passed, except the decree was obtained by fraud, &c. <i>Ib.</i>
LITTELL, ELIAKIM.	Authorised to institute and draw a lottery, the prizes of which shall consist of works of literature and science, 228
LOTTERIES.	Each of the commissioners of lotteries to give bond annually, with two sureties to be approved by the judges of Baltimore city court, which bond is to be recorded among the records of the Baltimore city court, 268 See Littell, Eliakim, and 228 — Lottery Tickets. — University of Maryland, and 261
LOTTERY TICKETS.	The sale of them regulated and restrained, 67 251 The seller of lottery tickets to obtain a license and give bond, &c. Penalty, &c. not to sell or offer for sale any ticket, or part thereof, in any lottery not authorised by this state, <i>Ib.</i> The sale of them in this state as authorised in the lottery for the disposal of the property of Thomas Jefferson, to be void, if the scheme
