5. And be it enacted, That the said commissioners, with By-laws to prethe agreement and consent of a majority of the voters of said in the town, shall have the power, under the penalties to be fixed on
by them, to make and pass, from time to time, by-laws or regulations to prevent any filth, litter, or obstruction whatever,
from being thrown or left in the streets or alleys of said town,
by any person or persons whatever, or by their permission or
direction.

- 6. And be it enacted, That the levy court of Worcester Overseer of streets county be and they are hereby authorised and required, to appoint annually some one person residing in the said town of Snow-Hill, an overseer of the streets of said town, who shall have the same powers and duties in keeping in repair the streets and alleys of the said town, by the labours of the persons residing within the limits of the said town, as are now, or shall hereafter be given to, and required of, the overseers of the public roads in Worcester county, or as may be given to, or required by, any by-law made as aforesaid, for the government of the said town.
- 7. And be it enacted, That the persons residing within the Inhabitants not limits of the said town shall not be compelled to labour, or bour on public contribute labour, to the repairing of any public road in Worcester county, without the limits of the said town, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

CHAP. LXXIV.

A Further Supplement to the act, entitled, An Act for making certain Passed Jan 17, 1827 Roads in Baltimore and Harford Counties, passed at December session eighteen hundred and fifteen, chapter forty-eight.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Time extended for That the time allowed for the making and finishing the turnpike road, authorised by the act to which this is a supplement, be and the same is hereby enlarged, and the further time of fifteen years, from the period so limited, be and is hereby given and allowed to the said company for the finishing the aforesaid turnpike road.

CHAP. LXXV.

An Act to establish the jurisdiction of Justices of the Peace and Constables Passed Jan 19, 1227 residing in the City of Annapolis, and Justices of the Peace and Constables of Anna-Arundel County, in certain cases therein mentioned.

Whereas great inconvenience and injury have been experi-preamble. enced by citizens of Anne-Arundel county, in consequence of the liability of their persons to seizure under warrants and executions whilst within the limits of the city of Annapolis, for the recovery of small debts previously contracted in said city; Therefore,

1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, No justice or contract from and after the passage of this act, no justice of the Ls to have jurispeace or constable residing in the city of Annapolis, shall have dents in Annajurisdiction over the persons of citizens resident of Anne-Arun-Arundel county whilst within the limits of said city, by issuing or
