On the 1st of January, 1795, the publishers of the Maryland Journal, consolidated their interests with the Advertiser, and issued the Maryland Journal and Baltimore universal daily advertiser. Printed by Philip Edwards & co. with the consecutive volume and number of the former." - Evans.
