(1) p. 19: "Nun ist 1799 der sonntags buchstabe F. folglich fängt sich das jahr mit dem dienstage an"; and (2) p. 27: "Die sonne regiert in diesem seculum nachfolgende jahre: 1800. 1807, 1814 [etc.]"

Not in Evans; Seidensticker, p. 159, lists another edition ("16mo. 80S.") under 1803.
