"Ordered, That the printer to the state be and he is hereby directed to print one hundred copies of every bill, resolution and report, containing subjects of a public nature which shall be read by the clerk during the session, also of all official papers, for the use of the members."—House V. & P., Nov. sess. 1806, p. 4 (Nov. 6).
