A variety of new and second-hand Books, the latter constituting the remains of a valuable private Library not disposed of on Saturday evening for want of time. Catalogues may be had at the room or at the store;" and on Nov. 27, 1807, as "This Evening, November 27th ... An entire private Library of Books, many of which are scarce and valuable ... Catalogues are now ready for delivery."
