Sir, The heavy losses to which mechanics and artisans, who follow the pursuit of erection and decorating buildings [14 lines] ... justice, should allow to those employed in erecting or furnishing houses, ... a lien on the property, until their honest claims are paid up. The Legislature of Pennsylvania, no less solicitous for the distribution of equal justice, and the guarantee of equal rights, at their session in March last, enacted a law to the same effect, a copy of which is hereunto annexed.
