

Records and for the copying of governmental records by photographic process when desired rather than by typewriting or handwriting were discussed.

Since no suitable candidate for the position of editorial assistant to collaborate in the publication of county records authorized by the Legislature was available, it was decided to postpone the employment of such an assistant until a later date.

The Commission decided that in the future it would meet semi-annually, in April and October, the day and hour to be fixed by the chairman. The Commission adjourned at 3:45 P. M.
