

During the fiscal year 1952, we carried forward \$9,867.35 from 1951 Budget Item No. 509. Of this amount \$9,271.45 was spent for a continuous-process photostat camera, \$216.04 for a Rheem booster heater for the new camera, \$352.00 for an MPE microfilm reader and \$27.86 was reverted to General Funds.

We also carried over \$2,082.22 from 1951 Budget Item No. 208A. Of this amount \$65.00 was spent for pencil drawings of the first, second and fourth prison at Annapolis (for Publication No. 9) and the remaining amount \$2,017.22 to be spent for the printing of Publication No. 8.
