In reply to your letter of July 16, 1958, I was glad to learn that the Oxford University Press had previously given you notice that the book was out of print and had been for a long time. I was not aware of Mr. Oman's letter of June 9, 1952, addressed to Governor McKeldin, at the time I wrote my first opinion. Had I had that information I would have reached the conclusion which I now do, that the agreement with the Oxford University Press has been terminated if it has declined to reprint or to publish a new edition of the work, provided demand has been made upon them to do so.
