lars, nor more than fifty dollars, for every such offence, and an additional fine of one dollar per day for every day that the said gate shall remain after judgment shall have been given against him, her or them for the first offence.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That all fines imposed by this act shall be recovered in the name of the state, before a justice of the peace for the county aforesaid, one half of which fine shall be appropriated to the informer, and the other half to the levy court of Cecil county, for the use of said county.

CHAPTER 107.

Passed March 3, 1828. **A supplement to the act, entitled, an act granting leave to the trustees of Lower West Nottingham Congregation, in Cecil county, and their successors, to receive a deed or deeds for, and hold the lands therein mentioned, passed at November session eighteen hundred and eight, chapter thirty-three.**

Preamble.

WHEREAS, it is represented, that the congregation designated in the act to which this is a supplement, by the name of Lower West Nottingham Presbyterian Congregation, had previous to the passage of said act, been incorporated by the name of Lower West Nottingham Presbyterian Church, in West Nottingham Hundred, Cecil County, State of Maryland—That the name mentioned in said act has been used in several deeds and proceedings, and it is feared that the use of it, instead of the said corporate name, may affect their title or claim to the property conveyed in pursuance of the said act, or in other respects be injurious to the rights of the said congregation, and the said congregation by their trustees have prayed that their corporate name may be declared to be Lower West Nottingham Presbyterian Church, and the acts of, and conveyances to their trustees on their behalf confirmed;—Therefore,

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the corporate name of the congregation described in the act to which this is a supplement, and thereby intended to be designated, is hereby changed to and declared to be, Lower West Nottingham Presbyterian Church, and the words, in West Nottingham hundred, in Cecil county, state of Maryland, used in the original incorporation, shall be deemed only to be descriptive of the location of the church of said congregation, and all acts and proceedings of the trustees of said church for or on behalf of the said congregation, by any other name, title, or description, are hereby declared to be as valid and effectual as if the said trustees had been described conformably to the charter or instrument of incorporation of the said congregation, and all conveyances and deeds made to the said trustees for the use of the said congregation pursuant to the act to which this is a supplement, shall, in virtue hereof, vest the title, interest and estate intended to be thereby conveyed in
