CHAPTER 155.

An act directing the payment of the salaries of the Clerks, Phy- Pased March 10, sician and other persons employed by the Directors of the Penitentiary.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Salarics payable to the directors of the Maryland Penitentiary, from and after the passage of this act, shall pay to the several persons employed by them as officers, agents, clerks, physician, deputy keepers, and so forth, of the Penitentiary, their salaries out of the funds of the institution, and the treasurer of the Western Shore of Maryland is hereby prohibited from paying any money for such salaries that does not accrue or become due before the passage of this act.
