

penalty of one hundred dollars, on or before the first day of January, in each and every year hereafter, to prepare and transmit to the treasurer of the Western Shore, a detailed statement of the aggregate of valuation, rate of tax per hundred dollars, amount of levy, and each general charge of expenditure, as full and complete, as may be in the several counties of this state, and in the city of Baltimore, in the form which accompanies this resolution, or as near thereto, as may consist with the said general charges, excepting so far as relates to the city of Baltimore, with respect to which, the form shall be adopted to the charges of the said city, and the statement shall also exhibit an account of the money received in the treasury of the said city; and it shall be the duty of the said treasurer to report to the legislature in the second week of every session, a general view of the said statements.

Resolutions in favor of the securities of Robert H. Scharf, late collector of the state tax, and of the county rate and assessment of Baltimore county.

Proceedings sus-
pended.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the attorney for and on behalf of the state of Maryland, in Baltimore county be, and he is hereby authorised and required, on all judgments now obtained or hereafter to be obtained, on suits depending in the county court of said county, against the securities of Robert H. Scharf, by appointment of the justices of the levy court of Baltimore county, late one of the collectors of the state tax imposed by the said justices in pursuance of an act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-five, entitled an act to provide a revenue for the support of government of this state, for all that part of the city of Baltimore comprising the sixth, seventh and eighth wards, and also by the said justices appointed late collector of the county rate or assessment imposed by said justices for the year eighteen hundred and twenty five, to stay all proceedings after judgments as aforesaid, against the said securities, or against the executors or administrators of said securities, until the first day of March which shall be in the year eighteen hundred and thirty: *Provided*, the said attorney for and on behalf of the state shall be of opinion that the amount due and owing on said judgement or judgments is well secured: *And provided also*, That all and any of said judgments, upon which proceedings shall be stayed as aforesaid, shall continue and remain in full force, and executions may be issued thereon at any time after the expiration of such stay.*

Resolved, That the said securities be, and they are hereby authorised to complete the collections of the said Robert H. Scharf.
