Clerk of city court of Baltimore to deposit forthwith all money received by him (excepting one per cent. for collecting the same) for licenses granted for selling lottery tickets, in such bank as shall be designated by, and to the credit of,

Said clerk to render semi annual accounts of such deposits to,

State wharfingers to deposit monthly to his credit, and in such bank as he shall designate, four fifths parts of all wharfage he may collect, &c.

Directed to pay over to the commissioners of primary schools for Anne Arundel county, the monies now in the treasury, not already invested, belonging to said county, so soon as said commissioners shall bond, &c.

Further directed to place in the Farmers' Bank of Maryland, to the credit of the commissioners of primary schools of Anne Arundel county, the dividends arising on the school fund already invested, and also all monies which shall hereafter be received in the treasury, belonging to the school fund of said county,

Directed to pay the distributive share of the school fund which the city of Baltimore is or may be entitled to, to the mayor and city council instead of the commissioners of the school fund for the city of Baltimore,

Directed to sell and transfer to the purchaser, the right of the state to subscribe for 1000 shares in the capital stock of the Union Bank of Maryland, provided he can obtain for said right ten dollars per share,

In case of sale as aforesaid, he is authorised and required to invest the sum he may receive, by subscribing for 134 shares of stock of said bank on account of the state,

Further authorised to pay \$50 in addition to the sum he may so receive, in order to complete the subscription and obtain the certificates for said 134 shares of stock,

Required to pay over to the trustees of the University of Maryland, all the unappropriated avails of the state lotteries; provided the said trustees on or before the
