

CHAP. 45. derick, gratuitously educated at St. Johns benevolent school; it shall be the duty of said superintendants, to pay to the said Rev'd. John M. Elroy, a portion of the money raised for the establishment of free schools, in Frederick, equal to the amount paid for the education of the same number of charity pupils, who may be educated at any other free school in Frederick, and the said superintendants shall make a return to the register of Frederick, of the number of pupils in St. John's benevolent school, together with the amount of money paid for their education, and make an estimate of the probable expenses, which may be incurred therein, for the next ensuing year, in the same manner and at the same time that is provided for their report, in reference to other free schools of Frederick; provided, always, that in estimating the amount to be paid for the use of St. John's benevolent school, the said superintendants shall include the sum now paid annually, for the benefit of said school, out of the school fund for Frederick county.

## CHAPTER 46.

Passed February 11  
1828.

*An additional supplement to an act, entitled, An act for the establishment and support of public free schools in the first election district of Baltimore county.*

Assessment made  
valid.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the appointment heretofore made by the justices of the levy court of Baltimore county, of a person to assess the property and register all adult white male citizens within the first election district of said county; and the assessment and returns which the said person shall make and deliver to the commissioners of said county, shall be of the same force and effect as if the said appointment and such assessment and returns had been respectively made at the time prescribed by law: Provided that the said assessment and returns shall be completed and delivered to the said commissioners on or before the last day of April next.*

Proviso.

Power to appoint  
assessors.

Sec. 2 *And be it enacted, That the commissioners of Baltimore county be, and they are hereby authorised and required to appoint a person or persons to assess the property, and register all white male adult inhabitants within the said election district, and make returns thereof to the said commissioners, as often as in the opinion of the said commissioners, any such appointment, assessment and returns shall become necessary to accomplish the purposes of the act to which this is an additional supplement: and the said commissioners shall have full power and authority at their pleasure to revoke any appointment which they make in pursuance of this act.*
