CHAP. 63.

Sec. 5. *And be it enacted*, That there shall be allowed to the solicitor employed in any petition filed under this act, and to the trustee and commissioner appointed by any decree passed by virtue of the same; such fee, compensation and commission as the court shall see proper to allow: *Provided*, That the commissions allowed to the said trustee shall not exceed ten per cent. upon the amount disbursed by him under the provisions of this act.

Sec. 6. *And be it enacted*, That the said orphans court shall have power and authority to pass any decree or order in the premises which they may consider necessary, in order to effect the several provisions of this act.

CHAPTER 64.

*An act to extend to Worcester county the provisions of the act of assembly entitled an act to declare certain trespasses felony, and for other purposes.*

Passed January 17 1828.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the several provisions of the act of assembly, entitled an act to declare certain trespasses felony and for other purposes, passed at December session eighteen hundred and twenty-six, be and the same are hereby extended to Worcester county; and that all that part of the third section of the said act which relates to Worcester county be and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 65.

*An act authorizing Thomas J. Mann to convey certain lands to David Webb and Mary his wife.*

Passed February 21 1828.

WHEREAS Thomas J. Mann by petition hath represented to the general assembly of Maryland, that on the eighth day of June eighteen hundred and twenty-seven his wife Millemty Mann was entitled to a right of reversion in and to three undivided fifth parts of certain tracts, parts of tracts or parcels of land called Presbury Chance and Little Worth, containing in the whole two hundred and sixty-six acres more or less, situate, lying and being on Chester river in Kent county: in and to which tracts, parts of tracts or parcels of land a certain Avarilia Williams has an estate for and during her natural life. That on the day and year aforesaid the said Thomas J. Mann and his wife made a contract with a certain David Webb of said county for the sale of all their interest
