## CHAPTER 80.

An additional supplement to the act, entitled, an act relating Passed February 29 to the city of Baltimore.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the board of commissioners of the tax for the city of Baltimore be, and the same is hereby abolished, and all the powers lawfully exercised by, or vested in it, and all the duties required by law to be performed by said commissioners shall be vested in, and performed by the mayor and city council of Baltimore

Commissioners of Tax abolished.

And be it enacted, That the mayor and city council Books and papers. of Baltimore be, and they are hereby authorised to receive and take into their charge, all and every the books, records, vouchers and other papers in the possession of, or belonging to the said commissioners of the tax for the city of Bal-

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That the jurors hereafter sum- Pay to jurors moned from the city of Baltimore for the trial of causes in Baltimore county court, shall be allowed for each and every day that they attend as jurors aforesaid, the sum of one dollar.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That the mayor and city coun-SEC. 4. And ve it enucted, That the highest state of levy, Mayor & city council of Baltimore be, and they are hereby authorised to levy, Mayor & city council to lay levy instead of the Levy an amount necessary to defray their proportion of the joint expenses of Baltimore county for the year eighteen hundred and twenty-seven, and of such other expenses for said year as have usually been levied on the city of Baltimore by the levy court of Baltimore county.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That the mayor and city council of Baltimore be, and they are hereby authorised to Time of laying lemake their levy of taxes on said city at any time that they may deem most advisable.

## CHAPTER 81.

An act to provide for electing commissioners for Harford county, and prescribing their powers and duties.

Passed Feb'ry. 29,

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the persons qualified to vote for delegates to the one commissioner general assembly, in Harford county, shall, at the time and to be elected for three years; from places of election in said county, on the first Monday in October each election district. next (and on the first Monday of October) in every three years
