CHAPTER 23.

AN ACT to repeal Chapter one hundred and seventy-six of the Acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and ninety-two, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 123 of Article 22 of Public Local Laws, title 'Washington County,' sub-title 'Election Districts,'" and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. That Chapter 176 of the Acts of the General Assembly Repeal of Maryland, passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and ninety two, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 123 of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Washington County,' sub-title 'Election Districts,'" be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows:

123. The County Commissioners shall have power and method authority to create new election districts in addition to those already established, whenever, in their judgment, the convenience of the voters of the county or any part thereof will thereby be promoted; and shall also have power to abridge or enlarge any districts heretofore established by the Legislature or which may hereafter be established by said commissioners; and shall have the further power to designate the places of holding the election polls in all election districts.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this act shall take enceutve. effect from the date of its passage.
