

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the name of said corporation shall be, and is hereby changed from the Hampden and Waverly Electric Light and Power company, to the Northern Electric company, <sup>Change of name.</sup>

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. <sup>Effective.</sup>

### CHAPTER 139.

AN ACT to repeal Section 232 B of Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Corporations," sub-title "Telegraph Companies," as enacted by the Act of 1892, Chapter 387, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section 232 B of Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Corporations," sub-title "Telegraph Companies," as enacted by the Act of 1892, chapter 387, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows: <sup>Repeal.</sup>

232 B. Where any two cities, towns or villages in the State of Maryland are connected by wire, operated, managed, controlled or owned by any individual, company or corporation, the price for the use of any telephone for the purpose of conversation between such cities, towns or villages, shall, for each five minutes or fraction of five minutes of such use, not exceed the amount hereby fixed, that is to say: where the distance does not exceed ten miles, fifteen cents; where the distance is more than ten miles and not more than thirty miles, twenty-five cents; where the distance is more than thirty miles and not more than fifty miles, one cent a mile; where the distance is more than fifty miles, fifty cents; and one-half a cent for each mile in excess of fifty miles. <sup>Charge for use of tele-phones.</sup>

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. <sup>Effective.</sup>
