CHAPTER 29.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of William J. C. Dulany Company, for stationery furnished for the use of the General Assembly of eighteen hundred and ninety-four, and the Executive Department, Court of Appeals and State library for eighteen hundred and ninety-four, and eighteen hundred and ninety-five, and the General Assembly of eighteen hundred and ninety-six.

Appropriation. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller of the State be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer of the State for the sum of seven thousand eight hundred and seventy-one dollars (\$7,871.00) for stationery furnished for the use of the General Assembly of eighteen hundred and ninety-four, and the Executive Department, Court of Appeals and State library for eighteen hundred and ninety-four and eighteen hundred and ninety five, and the General Assembly of eighteen hundred and ninety-six.

Effective.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 30.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 3 and 4 of Chapter five hundred and thirty-six of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, 1888, and to add an additional section to said Chapter five hundred and thirty-six; to increase the amount of the capital stock of the Hagerstown City Passenger Railway Company, reduce the par value of the shares thereof to five dollars (\$5), and empower the said company to construct and operate branch railroads from Hagerstown to certain towns in Washington County.

Repeal.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections 3 and 4 of Chapter five hundred and thirty-six of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, 1888, be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, so as to read as follows:
