any spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer or any kind of intoxicating drinks, whether of original manufacture or of a mixed character within the above described limits, shall on conviction, be subject to the same fines and punishments now provided by the Code of General Laws of Maryland, for selling spirituous or fermented liquors without a license.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect receive. from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 197.

AN ACT to authorize the Baltimore and Gunpowder Railroad Company to use electricity as a motor-power on the Philadelphia road, in Baltimore County, and to construct an electric railway thereon.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Baltimore and Gunpowder Railroad Company, a corporation under the general laws of the State of Maryland, May use elected and it is hereby authorized to use electricity, and the trolley system for motor-power, on passenger railway tracks on the Philadelphia road, in Baltimore county, and to construct and operate thereon a passenger and single or double track passenger railway, the consent of the County Commissioners of Baltimore county having been first obtained therefor, and upon such conditions as the said County Commissioners may impose.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect effective. from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 198.

AN ACT to amend Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Cecil County," sub-title "North East," by adding two additional sections thereto, to be known as Sections 195 p and 195 E.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of New sections.
