CHAPTER 33.

.104 A. In case of application by petition of a person who has been adjudged a lunatic or non compos mentis to have the Petition of commission superseded on the ground of recovery or restoration to a sound state of mind and capacity to manage his affairs, the petitioner shall be entitled to have the question submitted to a jury empaneled under the order of the court for the purpose, whose verdict shall be binding on the court,
